### Job Descriptions

**Volunteers working at ringside and inside the showring will be expected to wear appropriate apparel and footwear. (details to follow)**

**Announcer:** Calls classes, announces placings, award sponsors, winners, etc. **Color Commentator:** Talks about the breed in the ring while the show is going on. Does not interfere with judge and reasons. Gives breed history and development, standards for the breed, breed leaders, high scoring LA animals, former National Champions, Premier Sires, Premier Breeders and Exhibitors Educates the spectators about the breed. Will need to spend some time researching this information, help is available.

**Ring Set Up & Take Down:** Helps Jenny and Youth Reps set up and take down tables, chairs, awards and organize ribbons prior to the start of judging and at the competition of the judging for the day. Responsible for ring conditions during the show. Checks animals off as they enter the showring, helps judge keep animals moving and organized, writes down official placings in the ring after placements are made. Works with judges to keep show moving smoothly.

**Class/Animal CheckIn/Ring Steward.:** Checks animals off as they enter the showring Checks in animals on the judging sheets prior to the start of the class. Needs to be available before class is due to enter the ring so show is not delayed. Locates animals not checked in and makes sure they are in holding area and that animals due to compete for championships are at ringside at the proper time. , **Ring Steward** helps judge keep animals moving and organized, writes down official placings in the ring after placements are made. Works with judges to keep show moving smoothly.:

**Refreshments/ Serve Judges, Youth Rep & Ringmen:** Makes sure that judges, youth reps and staff working the showring are comfortable. **Contacts Judges about snack and drink preferences. Makes arrangements to have snacks and drinks available for judges,** and rest of showring personnel. Makes sure that snacks and beverages are replenished and that there are clean, comfortable places for them to sit and work. In charge of showring trash detail and hand washing materials for judges.

**Back Up Showmen:** Be ready at ring side in appropriate show whites to help anyone who needs an extra showman. With the 2 Ring format some people may need help getting animals shown, especially in group classes.

**Show Secretary:** Fills out ADGA Reports and marks Official Catalog for results. **Appointed by Greg Morris.**
